April 16, 2025

Welcome

The meeting was called to order by Vice Chair Harriet Snooks at 4:12 p.m.

In attendance: Frances Decker, MD; Amber Fordham, RN, MPH, DNP; Kerry Freeman, OD; Susan Harrison, NP; Christina Love; Sandra Hendrix; Harriet Snooks. Holly Lang was present via Zoom. Chairman Vicki Renfroe was absent due to a health issue.

Invocation and Positive Thoughts

Harriet talked to the group about the value, as a Board, of having shared goals, collaboration, and encouraging environment.

Approval of February minutes

February 12, 2025, minutes were reviewed by members present. Fran Decker moved to approve the minutes, and Kerry Freeman seconded. The minutes were fully approved.

Financial Report

- Amber Fordham gave an overview of the February and March Banking Summaries.
- The Banking Summary for February 2025 showed a beginning balance of \$94481 and an ending balance of \$115,367. A large re-order of paper charts was noted in the February Expenses. The Summary for March 2025 showed a beginning balance of \$115,367 and an ending balance of \$107,215.

Executive Director Report Highlights

- Seeing more walk-in patients for intake that are coming from the ER two to three times a week.
- Seeing an increased number of no-shows. Stephanie Atkins will start sending people letters in which we check on their phone numbers. A patient must cancel within 24 hours of an appointment.
- Susan Harrison talked to Dr. Kukucka about volunteering. They will talk again when he returns from a trip. There is a new physician in Springfield, Dr. Lauren Oglesby, that Amber will contact.
- Wandoo Abwa, GSU DPH student, gave a Zoom Power Point presentation at the meeting on cost benefit analysis, grant writing, and patient surveying. She will finish her degree in May 2026.
- We may be receiving a \$5000 donation from Chatham Orthopaedics (practice spelling) in 2025 second quarter, but we're not certain if it is recurring.
- Amber Fordham is the new Vice Chair for Family Connection and is helping them work on a strategic plan.

Medical Director Clinic Report

Susan Harrison reviewed the March 2025 Clinic Report which was included in the handouts.

- She noted that referrals are going well, especially with eye exams done by Effingham Eye Care.
- She reminded us that if Cologuard tests come back to the clinic as positive, we must be able to refer the patient to a specialist.

Old/Current Business

- Harriett Snooks, Holly Lang and Dr. Amber Fordham met with members of the County Commission at the Clinic. The meeting, to familiarize the Commission with the work of the Clinic, was very positive with good attitudes from all attendees. They said there might be a larger space available in Springfield for the Clinic in the not-too-distant future.

- Stephanie Atkins reported that the Parrish Building might be a possible event site for the October 2025 “10 Year Banquet.”
- Partnership with Dr. Tracy Durham resulted in \$24,000 of free care in 2024. Dr. Durham has some concerns that she discussed with Amber, but a list of Dental Referral Limitations was reviewed with the hope that referrals will be smoother and more complete.
- Amber recently communicated with Pride Philanthropy on investment updates and suggestions with regards to the donation from Dr. Decker. They discussed whether we could secure funds to hire someone such as a Case Manager to help get people signed up for Medicaid.

New Business

- Of the four 10-Year Celebrations, three are remaining: a Patient oriented event at the Mars Theater possibly in June, ~~Eran L.~~ ^{Franco} Decker Day in August, and the 10-Year Banquet in October.
- We plan to communicate with Pro Bono Partnership of Atlanta (PBPA) regarding getting legal advice. Amber Fordham and Chris Love will have a Zoom meeting with PBPA on April 24. If we contract with them, they would review our workforce readiness policies, offering only legal advice.
- Partnership with “Ready to Connect” program. It would be a 12-week session from 12:00 to 2:00 to train CMA’s that would be held at the Clinic and at Encompass, led by Destiny Bradshaw.

There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned at 5:35 p.m.

The next TRHC Board meeting will be on Wednesday, June 18, at 4:00 pm.






Emergency Room Services

In the year 2024, how many times did you visit the emergency room to receive care?

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

What was the main reason for visiting the emergency room?





Which emergency room did you visit to receive care? (check all that apply)






Over the **last 2 weeks**, how often have you been bothered by the following problems?




Are there other mental health services that you would like to see offered at Two Rivers?




Resource Needs




Please indicate whether you agree or disagree with the following statement regarding the above resources.




Please indicate whether you agree or disagree with the following statement regarding dental care.





Would you be open to using telehealth for accessing health services at 2RHC?





How comfortable do you feel using technology (phone calls, video calls) for accessing health services?






